

3rd and Final Circular

Zakopane Conference on Nuclear Physics entitled *Extremes of the Nuclear Landscape*, XLV in the series of Zakopane Schools of Physics, will be held in Zakopane, Poland, from August 30 - September 5, 2010.

The conference is organized by Henryk Niewodniczański Institute of Nuclear Physics of the Polish Academy of Sciences, Kraków, Marian Smoluchowski Institute of Physics of the Jagiellonian University, Kraków, and the Committee of Physics of the Polish Academy of Sciences.

Daily meals will be served in the hotel restaurants according to the accommodation place.

All the hotels provide free WiFi internet connection.

Information on the hotel assignment will be provided in a separate mail to be sent a few days before the conference.

Travel:

On August 30 (Monday), we will provide a bus transportation from Kraków to Zakopane. Conference buses (marked with the conference poster) will leave from:

- Downtown (Plac Jana Matejki) around 12:00 and 14:30,
- Kraków-Balice International Airport around 12:30 and 15:10.

There will be one of the organizers (handing the conference poster) who will assist you at the bus departure point.

The participants are requested to use the buses accordingly to their earlier registration.

Return buses from Zakopane to Kraków downtown (via airport) will be arranged on September 5 (Sunday). The buses will depart from Zakopane around 6:30, 9:00 and 10:30 (arriving at the airport around 9:00, 11:30 and 12:30 respectively, and downtown around 9:30, 12:00 and 13:00, resp.).

Those who will not use the conference buses may reach Zakopane by a public transport. There is a regular bus connection from the Kraków Regional Bus Station – RDA (<http://www.rda.krakow.pl>) to Zakopane. The buses leave every 10-20 minutes, the travel takes approximately 2 hours. There are trains connecting the airport with the Main Train Station that is next to RDA.

Registration:

The Conference Secretariat will operate daily in the Antałówka Conference House, the Registration Desk will be opened on Monday August 30, starting from 15 pm. Participants can check in directly in their hotels starting from 14 pm.

Conference proceedings:

Invited talks, contributed seminars and a five most excellent posters (selected by the Conference participants) will be a subject of a referee review and will be published in a special issue (March 2011) of *Acta Physica Polonica B*.
